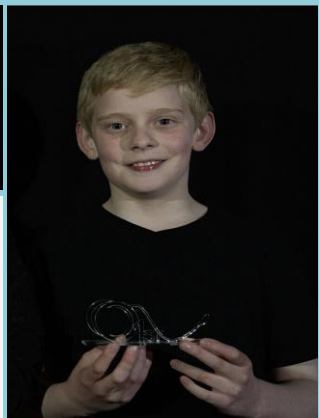

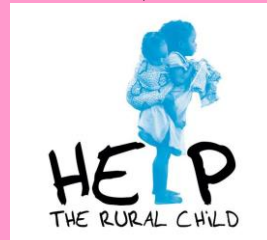
LITTLE LIBRARIES

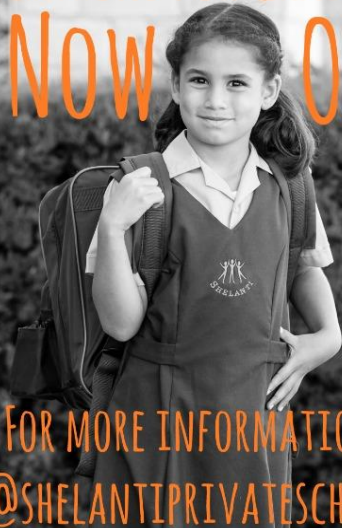
Little Libraries will be here from 9h00 - 14h00. Should parents wish to purchase books for both their children as well as donation purposes, after school.
