FEE STRUCTURE 2025

GRADE R

Shelanti Private School's tuition fees is tax deductible for qualifying taxpayers.
(Tax and Disability ITR-DD form)

Registration and Administration fee

R 2 700

Non-refundable, once off fee payable on registration

On acceptance into Grade 1 at Shelanti, the R 2 700 registration fee will be deducted from your Grade 1 registration fee.

Tuition fees

Includes: Marimba, Art, Drama Coding and Robotics, Sensory play, Sensory movement, Shine Circle and MiniChess

Grade R: R6 150 x12 months

Included: Aftercare at Shelanti Private School

Please note that R6 150 is payable irrespective of your child attending aftercare.

R18 450 per term

GRADE 1 – 7

Shelanti Private School's tuition fees is tax deductible for qualifying taxpayers. (Tax and Disability ITR-DD form)

Registration and administration fee

R11 000 for Grade 1 - 4

R 8 000 for Grade 5

R 6 000 for Grade 6 & 7

Non-refundable, once off fee payable on registration

Facility Fee

An annual facility fee of R 4 470 is payable on 15 December 2024 with your January 2024 tuition fees.

The facility fee **excludes**: your stationery, book fee, camps, school uniform, aftercare, holiday care and the purchasing of art at the art exhibition.

It **includes**: 4 outings a year.

The annual facility fee will be utilised to cover expenses relating to the upkeep of the building, procuring of educational material and robotics equipment, staff training and expenses relating to technology.

Aftercare fee 2025: 13:30-17:00

R 1 525 x12 this includes a light meal, fruit, assisted homework, activities, end of term party and exam prep for seniors.

R 18 300 per annum

Holiday care:

Holiday care will be offered twice a year, in the June Holiday and December holidays, times, dates and costs tbc closer to the time. These fees are not included in your school fees.

Tuition fees

Include Marimba, Art, Musical Theatre, Coding and Robotics. Mini - Cricket, Sensory play, Sensory movement, Shine Circle and MiniChess are also included for the Foundation Phase. It also includes the following extra mural activities: Drama, Marimba band, Hip Hop and Acapella.

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

As Shelanti is a no-cash institution a cash deposit fee will be added to your cash payment.

I/We confirm that this agreement is binding despite changes to my/our marital status, or any terms of settlement, which may arise from a divorce agreement.

In terms of Section 39 of the South African Schools Act, the parties to this form are liable to pay the compulsory school fees.

If payment is not received before the 5th of each month, the school reserves the right to charge a late payment fee of R100.00 per week until such time that the fees for the relevant month/s are paid. This late payment fee will automatically be added to your account.

I/We understand that our child will be refused entry to SHELANTI PRIVATE SCHOOL if payment is more than 7 days late and that I/We will be liable for the 3-month notice period.

I/We further agree, that in the event of my/our failing to pay tuition fees when the same are due, I/We will be liable for all attorney and own-client charges incurred by SHELANTI PRIVATE SCHOOL, to recover such fees, which costs shall include collection, commission and agents tracing fees.

I/We understand that our child will be refused entry to SHELANTI PRIVATE SCHOOL if payment is more than 7 days late and that I/We will be liable for the 3-month notice period.

I/We undertake to give 3 (three) months' notice, by the first week of the proposed final term, **in writing** of any intention to remove my/our child from the school and furthermore to return any books and/or equipment belonging to the school which our child may have. Shorter notice would require the payment of the following 3 months' tuition fees. In addition, should applications be secured, and learners not attend the school, the paid registration and administration fee will be forfeited.

I/We also understand that Shelanti Private School has the right to do a credit check on me/us the applicant/s.

I further understand that my Information will only be processed for the purpose for which it was collected and in terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act. I am aware that if I require further information, I could enquire about Shelanti's Privacy Statement and request to view the same.
