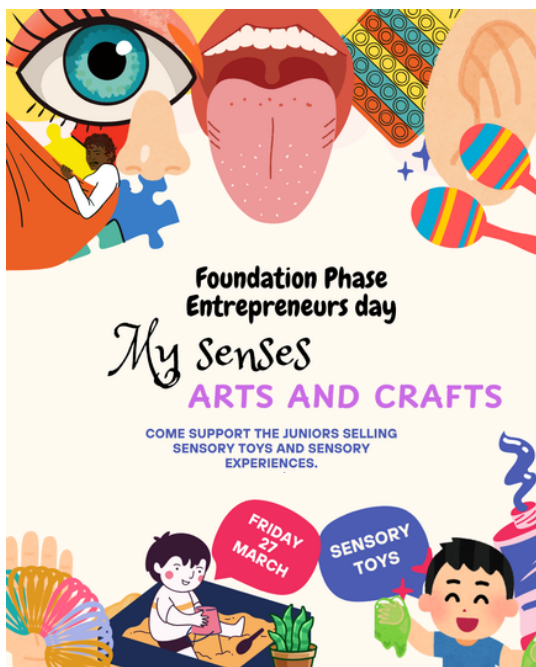




ANNOUNCEMENTS

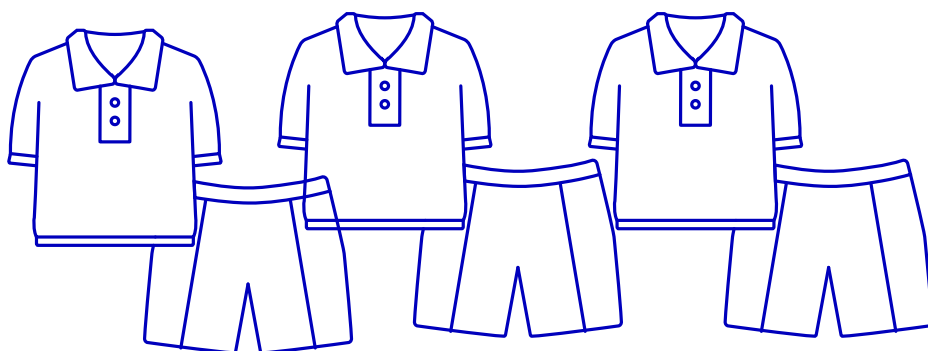
