New Behaviour Approach: “Carrying the Weight of Your Words”

At our school, we are committed to growing kind, respectful, and emotionally aware learners. As part of this, we are introducing a new restorative behaviour approach called “Carrying the Weight of Your Words.” Learners recently took part in a lesson about emotional baggage – the idea that everyone comes to school carrying their own feelings and experiences. We spoke about how our words can either add to someone’s emotional load or help lighten it through kindness and care. When a learner uses unkind or hurtful words, they will be given a reflective consequence during 2 break times, where they wear a lightly weighted backpack. This is not intended as punishment, but as a way to help them feel the impact of their words and build empathy. The weight is carefully monitored and completely safe.

Along with this, learners complete a short reflection and are guided to repair relationships through apology and better choices going forward. Our goal is to move beyond “just saying sorry” and instead help learners truly understand the impact of their language, take responsibility, and grow into more thoughtful, compassionate individuals.
