What motivates them?



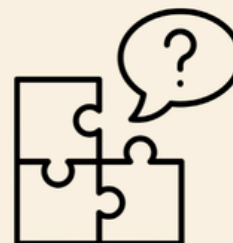
Attention and Interaction

What motivates them?



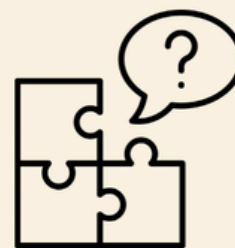
Challenges, choices, control

What motivates them?



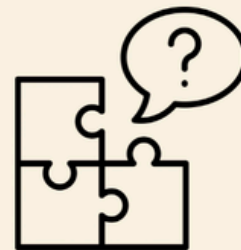
Acknowledgement and assurance

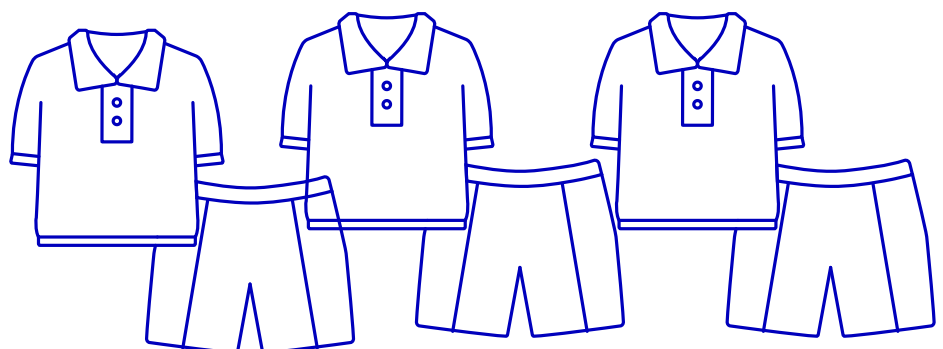
